We intentionally communicate our gratitude to God and one another

Gratitude is a Fork:

- One cleansed leper turned back. Nine cleansed lepers continued on (v.15)
- Romans 1:21 fork:
 - Although they knew God
 - Did not give thanks
 - Became futile in thinking
 - Foolish hearts were darkened

Gratitude is Human

- We expect it of OTHERS! (less so of self 😊)
- Parents always say to children: “what do you say?”
- Jesus expected it of all the cleansed lepers: “Where are the nine?”

Gratitude is a Door

- Cleansed leper who came back glorified God
- Gratitude glorifies the giver (John Piper)
- Cleansed leper who came back got saved
