- **Context**

- Jesus' final week
- Jesus' final public teaching
- Bookended with beautiful acts of devotion: anointed Feet and washed feet

- **Palm Sunday Fly-over**

- Misplaced expectations (v. 34; who is THIS Son of Man?)
- Jesus left and hid himself (v.36)
- Lots of Signs, No belief (v.37)
- Missed significance – (v.15,16; from Zech 9 “he shall speak peace to the nations”)

- **Greek Seek (v. 20-28)**

- We wish to see Jesus
- Andrew and Philip doing their thing

- **Jesus answered them**

- Look closely now (v.23; things are not as they appear)
- The King of Peace is enthroned on the cross
- The King of Peace compares himself to a grain of wheat
- The King of Peace has a troubled soul
 - What shall I say?
 - Not - - Save me from, but rather
 - Glorify your name through

- The King of Peace gets it done!
 - Judgment on the world (v.31)
 - Ruler of world cast out (v.31)
 - All people drawn to Jesus by way of cross (v. 32; mystery; surprising)
- A voice or a rumble?
 - Thunder (v.29)
 - Angel (v.29)
 - For your sake (v.30 “I have glorified my Name, and I will glorify my Name again”)
